THINK ABOUT THIS

PSALM 27

- NO ONE IS CERTAIN OF THE CONTEXT IN WHICH DAVID IS WRITING THIS PSALM, BUT IT'S OBVIOUS THAT THINGS AREN'T GOING SUPER AWESOME. VERSE 1 IS A DECLARATION THAT HE HAS NOTHING TO FEAR, NO MATTER THE CIRCUMSTANCE. IS IT EVER HARD FOR YOU TO SAY THAT? DO YOU THINK THAT'S OK?

- IN THE MIDST OF DAVID'S TRIAL, WHAT IS HIS RESPONSE TO IT ALL? (HINT: THE WORSHIP GUY IS WRITING THIS DEVO).

WHAT DO YOU THINK?

- PSALM 27 IS A PSALM OF LAMENT (IT'S SAD). A LOT OF THESE TYPES OF PSALMS END WITH DAVID SAYING THAT HE WILL "WAIT FOR THE LORD" LIKE HE DOES HERE IN V. 14. HOW DOES THAT MAKE YOU FEEL? IF I'M HONEST IT KINDA BUMS ME OUT. I'M NOT A BIG FAN OF WAITING. BUT GO READ ISAIAH 40:31. NOTICE THAT IT STARTS WITH FLYING, THEN RUNNING, THEN WALKING. YOU SEE, IN YOUR WAITING, THE LORD COMES AND MEETS YOU RIGHT WHERE YOU ARE. HE IS IN THE WAITING. NOT ON THE OTHER SIDE OF IT. IT'S IN THE WAITING THAT GOD IS FORMING US INTO WHO WE WERE MADE TO BE. WHAT ARE SOME TIMES IN YOUR LIFE YOU'VE WAITED FOR THE LORD? DID YOU SEE THE PURPOSE FOR IT?
